## Revelation 21:10-11 NLT

**<sup>10</sup> So he took me in the Spirit to a great, high mountain, and he showed me the holy city, Jerusalem, descending out of heaven from God. <sup>11</sup> It shone with the glory of God and sparkled like a precious stone—like jasper as clear as crystal.**

## Revelation 21:12-13 NLT

- <sup>12</sup> The city wall was broad and high, with twelve gates guarded by twelve angels. And the names of the twelve tribes of Israel were written on the gates.**
- <sup>13</sup> There were three gates on each side, east, north, south, and west.**



## Revelation 21:14-15 NLT

---

**<sup>14</sup> The wall of the city had twelve foundation stones, and on them were written the names of the twelve apostles of the Lamb.**

**<sup>15</sup> The angel who talked to me held in his hand a gold measuring stick to measure the city, its gates, and its wall.**

## Revelation 21:16-17 NLT

---

**<sup>16</sup> When he measured it, he found it was a square, as wide as it was long. In fact, its length and width and height were each 1,400 miles.<sup>17</sup> Then he measured the walls and found them to be 216 feet thick (according to the human standard used by the angel).**

## Revelation 21:18-19 NLT

**1<sup>8</sup> The wall was made of jasper, and the city was pure gold, as clear as glass.**

**1<sup>9</sup> The wall of the city was built on foundation stones inlaid with twelve precious stones: the first was jasper, the second sapphire, the third a gate, the fourth emerald.**

## Revelation 21:20-21 NLT

---

**<sup>20</sup> the fifth onyx, the sixth carnelian, the seventh chrysolite, the eighth beryl, the ninth topaz, the tenth chrysoprase, the eleventh jacinth, the twelfth amethyst.**

**<sup>21</sup> The twelve gates were made of pearls—each gate from a single pearl! And the main street was pure gold, as clear as glass**
