Study Title: The Two Made One

Devotional Reading: Romans 9:14-24

LESSON TEXT Ephesians 2:11-22 NRSV

INTRODUCTION

- **God's plan from the beginning was to unite all nations into one family through Christ.**
- **Our differences in culture, language, and background enrich the church's diversity.**
- **In today's text, Paul teaches the solution to heal a fractured, divided humanity.**

Background & History

- **Paul writes to Gentile believers in Ephesus, reminding them of their past separation from Israel.**
- **Gentiles faced Jewish council critique over rituals were acceptable to become a Christian.**
- **The divisive beliefs caused conflict and confusion,**
- **Paul teaches the significance of unity in Christ.**

GOALS FOR TODAY

- **1. Identify Jesus' purpose for the divided to be one in him.**
- **2. Understand how entitlement is not God's will.**
- **3. Illustrate how ALL believers can live in peace and unity with Christ as our center.**

The Two Made One

Ephesians 2:11-12 NRSV 

**11 Therefore, remember that formerly you
who are Gentiles by birth and called
“uncircumcised”**

**by those who call themselves “the
circumcision” (which is done in the body by
human hands)**

The Two Made One

Ephesians 2:12 NRSV 

12 Remember that at that time you were separate from Christ, excluded from citizenship in Israel and foreigners to the covenants of the promise, without hope and without God in the world.

KEY POINTS TO REMEMBER

- 1. Gentiles are not part of the Israel citizenship.**
- 2. Had no part in *the covenants of the promise*.**
- 3. Labeled without hope and without God.**
- 4. There was and is no true hope in any of the pagan religions.**

The Two Made One

Ephesians 2:13-14 NRSV 

13 But now in Christ Jesus you who once were far away have been brought near by the blood of Christ,

14 For he himself is our peace, who has made the two groups one and has destroyed the barrier, the dividing wall of hostility

The Two Made One

Ephesians 2:15-16 NRSV 

¹⁵ by setting aside in his flesh the law with its commands and regulations. His purpose was to create in himself one new humanity out of the two, thus making peace.

¹⁶ and in one body to reconcile both of them to God, through the cross, by which he put to death their hostility.

The Two Made One

Ephesians 2:17-18 NRSV 

17 He came and preached peace to you who were far away and peace to those who were near.

18 For through him we both have access to the Father by one Spirit.

KEY POINTS TO REMEMBER

- 1. By grace through faith in Jesus, God made it possible for all to live at peace with one another.**
- 2. Jesus' mission is to reconcile Jews and Gentiles.**
- 3. Reconciliation" originates from the Latin word "reconciliatio", meaning "renewal".**
- 4. To be reconciled means to have peace, harmony.**

The Two Made One

Ephesians 2:19-20 NRSV □

19 Consequently, you are no longer foreigners and strangers, but fellow citizens **with God's people and also members of his household,**

²⁰ built on the foundation of the apostles and prophets, with Christ Jesus himself as the chief cornerstone

The Two Made One

Ephesians 2:21-22 NRSV 

21 In him the whole building is joined together and rises to become a holy temple in the Lord.

22 And in him you too are being built together to become a dwelling in which God lives by his Spirit.
