### Introduction

The book of Nehemiah recounts the story of a later generation of Judeans having returned to Jerusalem and Judah in the third of three waves.

1<sup>st</sup>. Zerubabbel (Ezra Ch. 2:64-65)

2<sup>nd.</sup> Ezra. (Ch. 2 – 3). Worship restored.

3<sup>rd</sup>. Nehemiah (Nehemiah Ch.7: 5-73

### History and Background

- 1. The books of Ezra and Nehemiah chronicle the return in three phases.
- 2. Ezra 2:64-65 reveals about 50,000 people in the first with Zerubabbel.
- A later wave of approximately 5000, coming under the leadership of Ezra.
- 4. Nehemiah Led the last Phase of Israelites.

#### PERSONS PLACES AND EVENTS

Nehemiah – Esteemed Public Servant, Leader, Governor, man of great character.

**Ezra** — Priest, Scribe, teacher of the Law.

The People – Priests, Levites, Nethinims, temple servants, descendants of Solomon's servants, slaves, singers, thousands of animals.

# A Covenant Renewal Nehemiah 10:28 NRSV

28 The rest of the people, the priests, the Levites, the gatekeepers, the singers, the temple servants, and all who have separated themselves from the peoples of the lands to adhere to the law of God, their wives, their sons, their daughters, all who have knowledge and understanding,

# A Covenant Renewal Nehemiah 10:29 NRSV

29 join with their kin, their nobles, and enter into a curse and an oath to walk in God's law, which was given by Moses the servant of God, and to observe and do all the commandments of the Lord our Lord and his ordinances and his statutes.

# A Covenant Renewal Nehemiah 10:30 NRSV

<sup>30</sup> We will not give our daughters to the peoples of the land or take their daughters for our sons.

#### KEY POINTS TO REMEMBER

- 1. ALL joined together with an oath to follow the Law of God given through Moses.
- 2. They separated themselves away from others to keep the law. (Bad Company).
- 3. Those who remembered the cause for slavery knew the significance of obedience to the law.

# A Covenant Renewal Nehemiah 10:31 NRSV

<sup>31</sup> and if the peoples of the land bring in merchandise or any grain on the Sabbath day to sell, we will not buy it from them on the Sabbath or on a holy day, and we will forego the crops of the seventh year and the exaction of every debt.

# A Covenant Renewal Nehemiah 10:32 NRSV

We also lay on ourselves the obligation to charge ourselves yearly one-third of a shekel for the service of the house of our God:

# A Covenant Renewal Nehemiah 10:33 NRSV

33 for the rows of bread, the regular grain offering, the regular burnt offering, the Sabbaths, the new moons, the appointed festivals, the sacred donations, and the sin offerings to make atonement for Israel, and for all the work of the house of our God.

# A Covenant Renewal Nehemiah 10:34 NRSV

34 We have also cast lots among the priests, the Levites, and the people for the wood offering, to bring it into the house of our God, by ancestral houses, at appointed times, year by year, to burn on the altar of the LORD our God, as it is written in the law.

# A Covenant Renewal Nehemiah 10:35 NRSV

<sup>35</sup> We obligate ourselves to bring the first fruits of our soil and the first fruits of all fruit of every tree, year by year, to the house of the LORD

### A Covenant Renewal Nehemiah 10:36 NRSV

36 also to bring to the house of our God, to the priests who minister in the house of our God, the firstborn of our sons and of our livestock, as it is written in the law, and the firstlings of our herds and of our;

### A Covenant Renewal

#### Nehemiah 10:37 NRSV

37 and to bring the first of our dough, and our contributions, the fruit of every tree, the wine and the oil, to the priests, to the chambers of the house of our God; and to bring to the Levites the tithes from our soil, for it is the Levites who collect the tithes in all our rural towns.

# A Covenant Renewal Nehemiah 10:38 NRSV

<sup>38</sup> And the priest, the descendant of Aaron, shall be with the Levites when the Levites receive the tithes, and the Levites shall bring up a tithe of the tithes to the house of our God, to the chambers of the storehouse.

#### A Covenant Renewal

#### Nehemiah 10:39 NRSV

39 For the Israelites and the sons of Levi shall bring the contribution of grain, wine, and oil to the storerooms where the vessels of the sanctuary are and where the priests who minister and the gatekeepers and the singers are. We will not neglect the house of our God.
