Critical Services for East Oakland Families

The Family Life Center Campus is home to critical services and supports that nearly 10,000 people depend on each year.

It is the only resource center in East Oakland that is open to the public seven days per week from 7:00 am to 11:00 pm.

On any given evening, as one walks through the halls

of the Family Life Center, the sounds of piano, drum and violin lessons are mixed with the voices of men participating in anger management classes, youth grappling with math and English in after school tutorial sessions, and cheers from spectators at a basketball game or musical production taking place in the gymnasium.

The library is filled with literature, reference material and computers for job seekers to improve their resumes or gain access to information on employment opportunities. Low-income seniors and families come to the FLC to receive much-needed food and clothing, and attend an annual health fair to receive health, vision and dental exams and referrals.

State of the Campaign By Sister Constance Walker and Deacon Willis T. White, Jr.

This volunteer-led effort was spearheaded by the anointed Dr. J. Alfred Smith, Sr., and is of central importance to the church's efforts to ensure that the Family Life Center Campus continues to operate as a living testimony to his prophetic message, vision and major accomplishments.

The internal phase of the FLCC Campaign commenced in August of 2008. All agreed that it was important to demonstrate Allen Temple's internal commitment prior to seeking support from foundations, corporations and other external funders.

We are pleased to report a major milestone in our Campaign. In the first six months, we raised 30% of our internal goal -- nearly <u>\$800,000</u> in pledges and gifts from <u>265</u> donors. We accomplished this feat in the midst of a downturn in the economy and a leadership transition.

As we go forward, our goal is to attract <u>1000 donors</u>, including major donors as well as mid-range contributors at \$1,800 or \$3,000 over three years.

As co-chairs, we will shift our attention to the external phase of the campaign. Deacon Gerald Jones and Sister Lisa Clinton have generously agreed to lead the internal campaign in 2009.

State of the Campaign

The Capital Campaign is on the move. While we remain in the quiet phase of the campaign until we secure more than 50% of our total goal, we are working with the leaders of Allen Temple Ministries and Affiliated Nonprofits to re-introduce Allen Temple's Community Wellness Strategy to a crosssection of foundations and corporations via briefings

and tours.

The first briefing was held on April 9, 2009 and since that date, we have received \$60,000 in grants from the San Francisco Foundation: \$30,000 to the Allen Temple Health and Social Services Ministry to support their safety net services and \$30,000 in core support to the church toward the cost of hiring a Director of Development.

We are also conducting a mini-campaign to encourage church auxiliaries to identify naming opportunities and secure new pledges and contributions. The goal for the mini-campaign is to raise \$500,000 by October, 2009. We will provide regular updates on this important endeavor.
